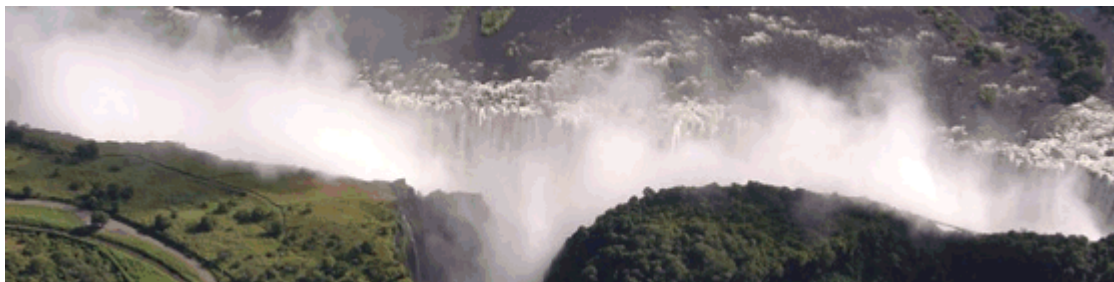


# Infections and Brain Disease Burden An International Neuroscience Retreat & Workshop

Members of the Middle Tennessee Chapter of the Society for Neuroscience, Nashville, USA, working in conjunction with their counterparts at the University of Zambia School of Medicine and the Epilepsy Association of Zambia will organize a neuroscience retreat and workshop in Zambia. The themes for the meeting will be: (a) **HIV/AIDS Dementia**, (b) **Cerebral Malaria**, (c) **Epilepsy**, and (d) **Chronic Depressive Disorders**. Speakers will come from Zambia and abroad.

**Audience** The meeting is open primarily to trainees and health professionals in Zambia and to members of the Middle Tennessee Chapter Society for Neuroscience, USA.

**Registration** Interested participants should submit an application letter indicating (a) their interest, (b) qualifications, (c) current work, and (d) relevance of the meeting to them. Applicants wanting to present at the meeting should submit an abstract with their application letter. Submission deadline for all materials is Friday, June 1, 2007.

**Abstract** The abstract text must be less than 300 words long including title, authors, institutions and addresses). Selection of abstracts will be based on scientific merit and relevance to the themes of the meeting.

**Fees** Final registration of selected applicants will be confirmed after full payment of ZMK100,000 per person by Zambian participants, whereas US\$100 is the fee to be paid by participants from the Middle Tennessee Chapter of the Society for Neuroscience. The deadline for payment of fees is Friday, June 8, 2007.

**Scholarships** Need-based scholarships are available to local participants using funds provided by the International Brain Research Organization. Award recipients will be notified by Friday, June 8, 2007.
